Change EOP Annex B Communications

II. SITUATION AND ASSUMPTIONS Change Paragraph 2 to read Paragraph 3 and add new Paragraph 2 as follows:

2. Communications sources from organized Amateur Radio Clubs or organization through the Harrison County Amateur Radio Emergency Coordinator (EC), and Amateur Radio Emergency Service (ARES) which:

- a. **Recruits, assigns, and trains individuals for ARES radio operations (net control and mobile operations).**
- b. **Assigns net control operators and organizes nets on:**
 - i. **2 meter and/or 70cms repeater station**
 - ii. **2 meter FM simplex net**
 - iii. **75/80 meter HF nets for out of county/and out of state communications.**
- c. **Provides communications between the Emergency Operation Center (EOC) and Designated locations (i.e., American Red Cross, Salvation Army, mass care shelters, reception centers etc.).**
- d. **Makes contact and establishes a communication link with adjacent counties, as necessary.**
- e. **Provides the necessary radio equipment and personnel for the County's Alternate, or Sub EOC, if and when each is established.**
- f. **Provides other emergency communications support where ever requested, within capabilities with County Organizations and/or Agencies.**
- g. **Each organization, department, or agency will provide continuous staffing of and ensure the operational capability of their communications equipment located in the EOC.**
- h. **Provide backup communications to the EOC, and/or the Mobile Command Post, as requested.**
